



USER GUIDE: USING THE PARENT TO PARENT (P2P) DATABASE

WHAT IS THE PARENT 2 PARENT (P2P) SPECIAL NEEDS DATABASE?

The Special Needs Database is a FREE online searchable resource. The database includes early interventionists, therapists, medical, dental, and other service providers across the state of Georgia who have indicated they serve children, youth and young adults (ages birth to 26) with disabilities. Information such as provider name, contact information, location, health plans accepted, description of services offered, and more is available on each provider's profile.

WHO SHOULD USE THIS DATABASE?

Families, patient navigators, community referral specialists, parent leaders/advocates/mentors, healthcare professionals, service providers, education transition specialists supporting children, youth and young adults throughout Georgia. Anyone and everyone who is searching for resources for the disability community.

WHY IS THIS DATABASE HELPFUL FOR CONNECTING FAMILIES TO EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES?

The Special Needs Database also serves as the Central Directory for the Babies Can't Wait Program, Georgia's early intervention program that offers a variety of coordinated services for infants and toddlers with special needs, from birth to three years of age, and their families. The Central Directory ensures the provision of a central directory and referral point for public and private early intervention services, resources, and experts available in GA.

HOW DO I ACCESS THE DATABASE?

You can search the database online following the steps below or you can call P2P at 1-800-229-2038 and someone will complete a search for you.

WHAT ARE THE MOST HELPFUL FEATURES ABOUT THE DATABASE?

Bilingual staff will provide one-on-one telephone assistance for the database at 1-800-229-2038. Healthcare and service providers who have completed the Georgia Statewide Disability and Health Program's disability competent care training, Responsive Practice, are identified in the database under "additional information" within their provider profile.
