Why is it important?

- Keeps your child interested and helps increase understanding
- Helps your child think deeply about the text
- Builds connections to things your child has seen or done
- Strengthens vocabulary and thinking skills



Parents can help by:

- Having conversations before, during, and after reading
- Asking open-ended questions about the text
- Encouraging readers to ask their own questions
- Focusing questions on connections and meaning
