TIMED REPEATED READING

What is it?

- A strategy to improve automaticity and fluency, two critical aspects of reading.
- It requires a child to read the same text multiple times to build familiarity and practice timing, inflection, and tone.

Parents can help by:



- Choosing a book or story on the child's reading level.
- Read the text aloud to demonstrate what a strong reader sounds like.
- Set the timer for one minute.
- Have the child read aloud for the entire minute.
- Provide feedback about word accuracy, timing, and tone.
- Repeat the process and encourage your child to read further each time.
