The primary responsibilities of the Parent Partner include providing one-on-one assistance and guidance on educational and health-related issues to families of children with disabilities and/or special healthcare needs and working closely with the staff at Chatham County Board of Health and Children with Special Healthcare Needs programs in Savannah, GA.

Requirements:

- Experience supporting families of children with special health care needs.
- Parent or family member of an individual with a disability and/or one year experience in the disability field.
- Good written and oral communication skills (preference given to candidates fluent in Spanish).
- Basic computer skills.
- 2-4 year degree preferred.
- Parent whose child has received services from Babies Can't Wait (BCW) or Children's Medical Services (CMS) preferred.

A Part-time in-office position is available, 20 hours a week and 12 months a year. Pay is \$17 per hour.

Interested candidates should include a cover letter detailing their experience of being a parent/family member of an individual with disability or supporting families of children with special health care needs.
